The Program

The CERRC Program aims to reduce diesel reliance for heat and power in rural and remote communities through the deployment and demonstration of renewable energy technologies, encouraging energy efficiency and building skills and capacity.

CERRC has \$220 million over six years (2018-2024) to support projects **located all across Canada** under two streams:

1. Clean Energy Projects; and
2. Capacity Building
